

## IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

S28 / NHTSA 16V-249

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

FCA has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain 2016 model year Jeep<sub>®</sub> Grand Cherokee vehicles.

The problem is... The Brake/Transmission Shift Interlock (BTSI) solenoid on your vehicle may have an incorrectly crimped electrical connector wire terminal(s). A loss of BTSI solenoid function could lead to the transmission gear selector becoming locked in the "Park" or

"Neutral" position. This condition could cause a crash without warning.

What your dealer FCA will repair your vehicle free of charge. To do this, your dealer will replace the gear selector assembly. The work will take about one hour to complete. However, additional

time may be necessary depending on service schedules.What you must do Simply contact your Chrysler, Jeep, Dodge or RAM dealer right away to schedule a

simply contact your Chrysler, Jeep, Dodge or RAM dealer right away to schedule a service appointment. Ask the dealer to hold the part for your vehicle or to order them before your appointment. Please bring this letter with you to your dealer.

If you have already experienced this specific condition and have paid to have it repaired, you may visit www.fcarecallreimbursement.com to submit your reimbursement request online or you can mail your original receipts and proof of payment to the following address for reimbursement consideration: FCA Customer Assistance, P.O. Box 21-8004, Auburn Hills, MI 48321-8007, Attention: Recall Reimbursement. Once we receive and verify the required documents, reimbursement will be sent to you within 60 days. If you've had previous repairs and/or reimbursement you may still need to have the recall repair performed on your vehicle.

If your dealer fails or is unable to remedy this defect without charge and within a reasonable time, you may submit a written complaint to the Administrator, National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, 1200 New Jersey Ave., S.E., Washington, DC 20590, or you can call the toll-free Vehicle Safety Hotline at 1-888-327-4236 (TTY 1-800-424-9153), or go to **safercar.gov**.
