

## IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

S40 / NHTSA 16V-288

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

FCA has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain 2011 through 2016 model vear Jeep<sub>®</sub> Wrangler vehicles.

In May 2013, FCA notified you, or the previous owner of this vehicle, of Safety Recall M31. Safety Recall S40 replaces Safety Recall M31. Safety Recall M31 will be cancelled. The current Safety Recall S40 notification contains the permanent remedy for this defect. The repair listed below is required even if the vehicle was previously repaired under Safety Recall M31.

The problem is...

The airbag clockspring on your vehicle may have been built with a steering column clockspring that may ingest dust if the vehicle is subjected to dusty environments. Dust inside the clockspring could compromise airbag circuit(s), cause illumination of the airbag warning light and/or a non-deployment of the driver airbag during a crash, increasing the risk of injury.

What your dealer will do...

**FCA will repair your vehicle free of charge.** To do this, your dealer will replace the steering column clockspring, steering wheel back cover, and steering column shrouds. The work will take about two hours to complete. However, additional time may be necessary depending on service schedules.

What you must do to ensure your safety...

Simply **contact your Chrysler, Jeep, Dodge or RAM dealer** right away to schedule a service appointment. Ask the dealer to hold the parts for your vehicle or to order them before your appointment. **Please bring this letter with you to your dealer.**

If you have already experienced this specific condition and have paid to have it repaired, you may visit www.fcarecallreimbursement.com to submit your reimbursement request online or you can mail your original receipts and proof of payment to the following address for reimbursement consideration: FCA Customer Assistance, P.O. Box 21-8004, Auburn Hills, MI 48321-8007, Attention: Recall Reimbursement. Once we receive and verify the required documents, reimbursement will be sent to you within 60 days. If you've had previous repairs and/or reimbursement you may still need to have the recall repair performed on your vehicle.

If your dealer fails or is unable to remedy this defect without charge and within a reasonable time, you may submit a written complaint to the Administrator, National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, 1200 New Jersey Ave., S.E., Washington, DC 20590, or you can call the toll-free Vehicle Safety Hotline at 1-888-327-4236 (TTY 1-800-424-9153), or go to **safercar.gov**.
